Rear: Im Feld 2 / PFENNINGE / 1863. Unterhalb eines Trennstrichs Münzstättenkürzel A.

Pierced: Intentional hole(s) pierced through a coin so that it can be worn on a necklace, sewn onto textiles, etc. In case of paper money such a perforation often indicates devaluation.
